1- Food distribution projects

The Horan Association has implemented 3 projects in the distribution of food baskets. Sphere standards meet the minimum requirements for food security in Horan and Quneitra, 5250 beneficiaries. The budget is \$ 240,788.

2- Food distribution projects cooked and uncooked

The Horan Association has implemented 7 projects for the distribution of ready meals and 2 projects for the distribution of meat rations through the projects of sacrifice and others.
